In HSCA Box 281, Agency File Number (folder) 014747, there are eight FBI documents relating to James Jarman, one of the TSBD employees on the fifth floor at the time of the assassination. For whatever reason, the withdrawal slip for these documents, present in the public boxes at NARA II, indicates a USSS referral. They obviously should have been referred to the Bureau but apparently weren't (I checked the referral sheets in your box). I would guess they're all pretty routine. Should I copy them to give to you? Should I include them on a memo? I'd appreciate your thoughts.
