This time she called me back, indicated that she hadn't personally seen the two documents.

I told her that wouldn't be a problem. She asked several general questions about the JFK Act (she clearly had not seen the explanatory material we forwarded with our 8/21 letter) and I filled her in as best I could. Having spoken with her, I think the other reason she returned my call this time is that the Bureau of Prisons has apparently had some JFK documents forwarded to them via other agencies who are trying to process their own documents and occasionally come across Bureau of Prison equities (she mentioned the USSS had sent them one or more records), and I get the impression the B of P doesn't know quite what to do with them. Again, I straightened her out as best I could. She promised to get back to me on the two HSCA documents in question.
