I expect you to devote a percentage of your time to FBI issues and to keep me fully informedwhen you feel that you are unable to complete all of your assigned work. I fear that you aretrying to make a some sort of point through your decision not to review the FBI records, and thatyou are consequently not acting in a manner that is in the best interests of this office.
