He was very cooperative. He confirmed that he has original notes, approximately 100, that he has stored in his garage and which were the basis for part of the rough manuscript he prepared for his book, "Mob Lawyer." He confirmed that the notes include notes he made soon after the fact of the 1987 conversation with Trafficante re the Kennedy assassination, as well as similar notes he made at the time with respect to other conversations about the Kennedy assassination that he recounted from the 1960's. He said the notes are kept in envelopes and he has to dig them out of his garage. He would be willing to let us review the originals but wants to check with his co-author, Selwyn Raab. I suggested that we could come to Tampa to review them or meet with him in New York City (he plans a trip there although he is not certain of the date). He asked me to call him Monday morning after he speaks with Raab.Although I did not raise the issue with him, I think we should consider deposing him in connection with the review of the notes in order to authenticate these notes under oath and to inquire as to other corroborating materials that Ragano might have.
