I wouldn't feel comfortable signing it as it now stands. It strikes me that OSU has a broad interest in an ongoing relationship with the RSHU, while the ARRB has a limited and focused interest in engaging the services of Russian reseachers for a defined purpose. It may be that separate agreements that are tailored for the specific goals of the respective institutions would be a better approach. Could, for instance, there be a Statement of Collaboration between OSU and the RSHU that would could mention the JFK project as an example of the collaborative work? The Board could then sign an agreement with the RSHU that would detail the specifics of the research project. I am eager to discuss this issue with you.
