A woman named Jean Lord from St. Paul, MN called last week after seeing the news story about the Powers film. She said she had always wanted to tell the authorities about something she had heard a few days prior to the assassination. Growing up she knew a family acquaintance named Artur Kuche. He was a Lt. Colonel in Hitler's army, his wife was Hitler's seamstress. Kuche then began teaching in Minnesota and shortly before the assassination he went to Washington, DC to receive a teaching award from President Kennedy. Just before he was to go to Washington, Ms. Lord heard him say something like "When I go to Washington, Kennedy is going to Dallas after that, and after he's gone and Nixon gets in, it will be easier for me to go to Russia." Lord is not sure if this is anything but wanted to tell us about it. She said he (Kuche) was in Russia a lot and she thinks he may have been a spy.
