I spoke with GSA travel policy office regarding travel regs relating to witnesses and they referred me to DOJ. I spoke with Ms. Violet Foster (307-1954) concerning our question of whether or not it is appropriate to pay for a spouse to travel with a witness due to medical needs. She informed me that although there is no specific reg dealing with this, DOJ handles this by requesting a statement from the witness' doctor and then paying for the spouse. She also mentioned that they often pay for spouses if the witness is elderly. She mentioned that the relevant citations are 28USC, 1821 and 28CFR, part 21.
