These include the home addresses and phone numbers in the Fact Sheet on the 112th Intelligence Corps, the home addresses in Fact Sheet on Personnel Involved in Oswald's Discharge and serial numbers from Fact Sheet on Tentative Identifications. I have recommended "release" on all of these redactions on the basis that DOD has provided no information to confirm that 1) the individuals are still alive, and/or 2) the addresses listed in the documents are still current.Jeremy has suggested that Dave Montague do a FinCen search on the individuals in these documents so that we can satisfy ourselves as to their status. Dave is going to work on this tomorrow (Friday) and, depending on how his efforts go, we may or may not actually bring this document to the Board next week.Lastly, on a related subject, I have put into the Consent Database the six (6) documents that Stewart Aly said could be released in his letter of March 6th. These documents will not go to the Board, but will be referenced in the Federal Register notice associated with next week's Board meeting.
