I agreed it could be submitted on January 21, 1997. In addition, Ms. Spencer described generally how she is approaching the Statement of Compliance: the Air Force will describe the commands that have been tasked to search for records and what their responses were. Except in one case, all the responses were negative. I asked Ms. Spencer to attach to the Statement of Compliance the tasking memo, and the responses of the various commands. With respect to all statements of compliance, we may want to ask the agency to attach the tasking directives and responses as exhibits to the Statement of Compliance. The only record located by the Air Force, according to Ms. Spencer, was a flight log from Andrews Air Force Base, which she said had been provided to the Review Board.Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
