PS there is an additional document of particular interest that I will tell you about personally.-- Manuel Among the CIA (and related) documents voted on the the Assassination Records Review Board at its December meeting are:-CIA Counterintelligence Chief James Angleton's testimony to the House Select Committee on Assassinations;- Correspondence between the Agency and the Warren Commission, including a Counterintelligence Staff response to the Warren Commission's questions regarding Oswald's stay in the Soviet Union, and his subsequent return to the United States; - Correspondence between the CIA and the HSCA, regarding, among other items, HSCA informational requests;-Monthly reports from the Mexico City photographic surveillance operations; -Cables from the Mexico City station regarding Oswald's visit in September and October, 1963;-Cables from around the world regarding the assassination from the time frame surrounding the assassination and during various governmental investigations;- a document regarding correspondence between Oswald and his mother while Oswald was residing in the Soviet Union;-internal documents related to the CIA's interest in the Jim Garrison Investigation.
