He confirmed that he has none of his father's papers. He did say that the only thing his father ever told the family about the Kennedy assassination was to complain that he "didn't understand why they never asked me." I asked him who "they" meant, and he said it meant the Warren Commission. Like his brother Richard, he recommended I contact his sister Nancy Denlea in Los Angeles; I told him that I was in the process of doing that , with Richard's assistance. Like Richard, he stated that his father never discussed details of any of his work with either Presidents Kennedy or Johnson, not even the death of President Kennedy, with anyone...not even with his family in private, except to complain that the Warren Commission had not contacted him. Incidentally, he clarified that the wreck he is diving on is the Spanish Galleon Santa Magdalena, which went aground off the island of Rota in the Marianas (not Rota, Spain as I had presumed earlier) in the year 1601 enroute Acapulco from Manila.
