During a three hour meeting we discussed their compliance statement and how they arrived at the determinations made within the letter. In addition, other topics discussed, which provided background and context to the statement, were the destruction of the Oswald file, the various resource files at IRR and how IRR is integrated into the U.S. Army Intelligence organizational structure. We further discussed the kinds of records stored at IRR and where other Army Intelligence records might be stored. At the conclusion of the meeting we told them that ARRB would send a letter to IRR explaining further issues of compliance, and committing to the record a list of names which we have, in the past, requested DCII searches. We also intend to prioritize names and organizations contained within that list which are to be searched in their microfiche collection.

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
