Subject: Inconsistency Between Edgewood Arsenal Report (1965) and Humes/Boswell ARRB Deposition Testimony

Joe was discussing ballistic and medical matters with me yesterday, and showed me the first page of the 1965 report, which states that Edgewood personnel met with Drs. Humes, Boswell and Finck.I immediately realized that this statement conflicted with the answers Drs. Humes and Boswell gave, under oath, to ARRB's Edgewood questions. (Dr. Finck was not asked Edgewood questions.) I loaded the corrected transcripts into my hard drive, performed a word search, and found the relevant parts of their testimonies--they did indeed deny any contact with Edgewood. (I printed the relevant pages from the ARRB Depo transcripts from the disc information, so the pagination is different from in the paper versions.) I have discussed this with Joe, and we both feel that, based on this inconsistency, it is probably well worth our while to have Joe contact surviving Edgewood personnel involved in this study to try to further ascertain exactly what kind of interface may have actually occurred between Humes, Boswell, Finck and Edgewood personnel. Joe is now reviewing the Warren Commission testimony of various Edgewood personnel. Copies of the relevant pages are in your "A" box. END
