Review Board's representative in the call: Brian RosenDepartment of the Army's representative in the call: Jeff PorterDescription of the Call Date: 02/03/97Subject: Records at the Office of the Provost Marshall GeneralSummary of the Call:I originally spoke with Mr. Porter on 1/29/97 in an effort to follow up on the suggestion of Phillip McGuire of Army CID that routine staff notes or files of Provost Marshall personnel from 1962-1964 might have remained with the Office of the Provost Marshall rather than having been sent for storage with CID. When I first spoke with him, Mr. Porter confirmed that all military police reports, Reports of Investigations ("ROI's) and Requests for Assistance would be stored with CID. He also agreed that less formal documents might have remained with the Office of the Provost Marshall. However, he stated that such documents are routinely destroyed each year and likely no longer existed. He agreed to check the records over the weekend and report back to me (as historian for the office he has access to the relevant records). I spoke with Mr. Porter again this morning. He informed me that he had searched all the records and found nothing relevant to my inquiry.
