[Wray had previously checked MHI holdings for records from 112th INTC Group, 316th INTC Detachment, and personal papers from Maxwell Taylor and other senior Army officials.) Rakers said MHI has copies of the 1963 issues of the Defense Intelligence Digest, a weekly intelligence summary produced by DIA; as well as copies of "DA G2," an Army intelligence officials (e.g. ACSI, etc.) in MHI's holdings; however, this is a hit-and-miss collection because there is no official program to assemble personal papers, and it therefore depends more on the initiative of the individual involved.Wray agreed to send Rakers a list of senior Army officials from the time of the JFK assassination for him to run through their holdings index. Wray and Masih may visit MHI at some time in the near future to review intelligence reports.Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
