Subject: Possible Subpoena to Herbert J. (Jack) Miller

Jack Miller was the Assistant Attorney General for the Criminal Division during the Kennedy administration. He has also been the principal lawyer representing Nixon in the ongoing battles with NARA over the Nixon records. He similarly represented Nixon during the Church Committee's many attempts to obtain information. When the JFK Library (improperly) returned the Walter Sheridan papers to the Sheridans, Jack Miller became their counsel. More than one year ago I contacted him about the Sheridan papers and he agreed to get back to me shortly. I have left a dozen messages for him over the last year, which he has not returned. From the Church Committee experience, the NARA experience, and my own experience, he is not someone who is willing to cooperate. He prefers to stall. According to Sy Hersh, Miller was one of the four people (including Sheridan) who was cognizant of the Bobby Kennedy inquiry into the assassination. I propose that we request DOJ to issue a subpoena to Miller for all information that he has regarding the JFK

assassination, including any information on an investigation conducted by Bobby Kennedy. This request would

cover times that Miller was a Federal employee.
