I offered her a counterproposal, on behalf of the ARRB Executive Director and the ARRB General Counsel, as follows: allow ARRB to hire a day-nurse for her mother, and simultaneously fly her to Washington to testify that same afternoon, and then fly home again that evening. I explained that this proposed solution was driven by our inability to remove Kennedy family Deed-of-Gift materials (e.g., autopsy photographs) from the National Archives. [The scenario which supports this has her leaving Joplin at 6:45 A.M.; arriving National Airport, via Memphis, at 11:38 A.M.; departing National at 5:59 P.M., and arriving home at Joplin, via Memphis, at 9:55 P.M. the same day.]She said that her mother's health was a day-to-day question mark, and asked what date we had in mind. I responded that generally, we had the May or June time period in mind, and that the specific date for which we obtained the flight times proposed above was May 15, but that we would be as flexible as we possibly could in responding to her needs. She said she would like to check out a few things, and consider our offer. She said she would call back sometime within the next week. I told her that if I were unavailable for any reason, she should ask for Mr. Gunn. ENDDon't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for
