While it may be only a "representation," it remains the centralpiece of evidence-- THE assassination record-- concerning the event. I findit difficult to ignore that, or to contemplate how we can cede it back toprivate hands. Have the Zapruder's said anything more on the matter? And what haveyou heard of public reaction to the \$26 million the feds propose to pay forthe Nixon Papers? A comparable siutation? I look forward to our talk on Friday... --Bill
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
