Tony Jr. reiterated that although his father is not expressing any animosity towards the Board, he wants to "leave history alone" and is not interested in talking to us. I explained again that the general scope of questioning was laid out in the original letter we sent to Tony Sr. and emphasized that our mandate was different than any other agencies or congressional committees that had previously interviewed his father. He said that his father understood, but still wanted to "leave history alone." I told him that I would file my report and that a subpoena would be considered. Tony Jr. said that he understood that we had a job to do. The conversation ended amicably, as always. I recommend that we subpoena Tony Vecianna, Sr. and make whatever arrangements are necessary and reasonable to interview him.
