once worked for UPI. Harnettworked 1951-1987 wire editor in the San Francisco Bureau of UPI. He's currently  
retired & publishes a newsletter called "95" (meaning urgent), intended for former UPI personnel  
("Unipressers").Harnett was cordial & said the following:-he is not familiar w/such a story (from McCarthy's  
book) related to UPI-H. Roger Tatarian is dead; widow is "Eunice Tatarian" 5302 N. Colonial Avenue #101,  
Fresno, CA 93704 (209.446.0446)-he provided the same phone # (413.698.3247) we found for William Sexton  
(UPI National News Editor in 1962)-he believes that UPI would not have w/held a story at the request of the  
Govenment unlessthe source(s) were not very credible-believes the Washington, DC Bureau of UPI would  
certainly have known about any story of such magnitude & the final judgement would have been made by the  
senior editors in NYC.-UPI's White House Correspondent Merriman Smith (committed suicide in the early  
1970's) won a pulitzer prize for his coverage of the JFK assassination; Smith may have written memoires of his  
career.Harnett will look for the following & contact us:-name of UPI State Dept correspondent during the  
1960s-name of possible UPI CIA or other intelligence correspondent during the 1960s-names of other people  
he'd recommend we speak with-information on Thomas Zumbo (former UPI reporter close to McCarthy in
