Subject: USSS equities in HSCA documents
The Secret Service has stated that NARA referred 800 documents from the HSCA collection. Of those 800 documents, the Secret Service presented 56 documents with requested postponements to the Review Board. The Service returned the remaining documents to NARA for inclusion in the JFK Collection without any requested postponements. With the exception of about 4 documents with agent addresses or social security numbers and another 5 or so documents (one of which contains 413 postponement requests) the Review Board voted to open them in full. Those 5 documents are still under consideration by the Review Board. The Secret Service has not yet appealed any Board decisions. In addition, out of 45 protective surveys for President Kennedy (March-November 1963) designated assassination records by the Review Board, the Service has requested postponements in 12. These are still under consideration.
