Subject: more USSS information

I have counted approximately 5700 pages of material (plus a cassette tape of an interview with Chief Rowley) transferred to NARA by the Secret Service since January 1996. These records supplement the Service's Official Case File, which was transferred to the Archives in 1979, and they reflect new contributions to the JFK Collection directly from Secret Service files. Highlights include: The Service's response to William Manchester's Death of a President Newspaper clippings and transcripts of news conferences (November 21-25, 1963) Letters from the public responding to the assassination Secret Service files on protection of the President Correspondence with the Warren Commission, the HSCA, and the Church Committee Protective survey reports for President Kennedy Comments on legislation making presidential assassination a federal crime Protective Intelligence files on individuals: Richard Case Nagell, Pedro Diaz Lanz, Raymond Broshears (we have requested 144 more files on Cubans) Director's Briefing Book for appearance before the HSCA Internal memos by Chief James Rowley (1963-1964) Analysis of Secret Service protective policies before and after the Kennedy assassination Report and files on Abraham Bolden Collection of reports from the New York Field office A classified document log book Personnel files for White House Detail Office of Investigation Reports Testimony by Chief Rowley and Inspector Thomas Kelley at the Kerner hearings on violence (1968)
