Mr. Fogel asked for additional time to August 1, which I agreed to.Mr. Fogel indicated that the Criminal Division has dealt with a backlog of documents to be declassified, but it is my understanding that not much progress has been made in attempting to locate and retrieve the files that we had identified, particularly the organized crime files. Mr. Fogel indicated that the person most familiar with the Division's files, Les Rowe, Deputy Director of Administration and with DOJ for 25 years, is the key person they need but has been unavailable because he is on assignment, I believe, to INS.
