I spoke with John Machado this morning. He said that if the computer printout says "yes" in the "physical file" line that means the Service still has the complete file. I told him I would let him know which files we are interested in. I told him we want to see the log book or relevant pages. He initially said he might bring it over here at a specific time so we could look at it, and then he would carry it back to his office. After a few minutes, he then said he will "run this past Vezeris" to suggest a way for us to see it. John said that even if the Service destroys a file, they still keep the computer printout because it contains so many cross-references. If a specific file is deleted, all the cross-references would disappear. He said he would double check this. He said the computer printouts are for USSS use only and are not routinely made available to other agencies. The Service will share them with other agencies if they specifically ask.
