We have asked SSA to collect and preserve all earnings information for Lee Harvey Oswald and Jack Ruby pending any later determination as to the releasability of this information. Ms. Rieger sought clarification as to the years for which we wanted earnings information for Ruby; I confirmed that we wanted earnings information for all years that were reported in Warren Commission Exhibit 1318 relating to Ruby's employment history. In addition, Ms. Rieger confirmed that they will collect earnings information for Oswald for all years of his employment. Earnings information will include the quarterly statements filed by Oswald's and Ruby's employers (which would report employee earnings), as well as the employer's application for an employer identification number. It is my understanding that, at this time, SSA takes the position that this information is not releasable under Section 6103 of the IRS Code. Nonetheless, based on my conversation with Ms. Rieger, SSA has no objection to collecting and preserving these records and is proceeding to do so.Don't
