In response to Jeremy's email: There are 4 boxes (boxes 2-5) of Secret Service trip files (aka protective surveys) in Steve Tilley's office. In box 4, you will find 2 folders on Kennedy's June 29, 1962 trip to Mexico City. These surveys are not yet open to the public; if you make copies, they should be kept in the SCIF. Another group of records supplements the USSS protective surveys. The State Department's Bureau of Diplomatic Security has cables from other agencies on this Mexico City trip. We have these records in our SCIF. I'll show you where they are if you wish to see them.
