Subject: Max Phillips

Michelle just called to give some highlights of the interview. Phillips did not bring the copy of the Zapruder film from Dallas to Washington. Phillips is not Bill Smith. Phillips has never heard of a USSS employee named Bill Smith. Phillips said that Bouck knew Angleton quite well and had several contacts at CIA. Phillips said that if the USSS wanted still photos developed, the Service would have gone to the CIA. Phillips was called back to Washington on the 23rd because of a Secret Service manpower shortage, and he participated in security for the funeral. Phillips happened to be in Austin on November 22, 1963, (for reasons Michelle will explain in her report) on a matter unrelated to President Kennedy's trip. Phillips carried a Carcano rifle, which he had obtained in Dallas, back to Washington (apparently for tests). Phillips obtained a copy of the Zapruder film directly from Mr. Zapruder. Phillips left it with Forrest Sorrels' administrative assistant in Dallas. Phillips does not know who carried the film to Washington. No major revelations.
