In the sixth paragraph on the first page, "those files" (four linesfrom the end) should have been "destroyed ONI Oswald files." That is, thefollowing two sentences (as corrected) refer to completely differentsubjects: "In connection with autopsy records, I wrote about the hypothesis ofthe 'national security' autopsy in part because I thought you might nothear that idea from anyone else. I told you about a possible sourceclaiming knowledge of destroyed ONI Oswald files, even though he was knownto me only indirectly and was not indisputably credible, because I expectedthat you would not know of him if I did not bring him to your attentionmyself."
