Subject: July Board Meeting: Draft

The board considered 72 documents at the July meeting. Approximately 2/3 of these documents came from the CIA, while the remainder were from the HSCA. Cable traffic to and from Mexico City dealing with operational considerations and personnel matters made up the vast majority of CIA material. The remainder consisted largely of documents relating to anti-Castro operations in general, and included a few documents dealing with Jim Garrison's charges of CIA involvement in the assassination. Approximately 2/3 of the HSCA material consisted of a list of CIA and Warren Commission files reviewed by the committee, which range from 201 files on various persons to cable traffic and other sorts of memoranda. In most cases, a brief abstract of the document is included in the list. The remainder of the HSCA documents relate to Oswald's movements in Mexico City and in Russia, CIA assassination plots against Castro, and the Mafia.
