Review Board's representative in the call: Ron HaronThe House of Representatives clerk's office's representative in the call: Ray StrongDescription of the Call Date: 10/31/97Subject: Congressional (House) RecordsSummary of the Call:Ray Strong, Assistant to the Clerk of the House, called to introduce himself and to confirm that the Clerk's Office had received our October 30 letter requesting further assistance in releasing Congressional records relating to the assassination. He apologized on behalf of the Clerk for not responding to our earlier November 1996 letter and he explained that this correspondence somehow got lost internally and was not brought to the attention of the Clerk, Ms. Robin Carle. He said Ms. Carle will be reviewing our October 30 letter and that the Clerk's office would "address" our concerns "immediately." Mr. Strong said he would call me early next week to follow-up on these matters. I reiterated that we need authorization in writing that will allow us to inspect certain committee records (and obtain indices) and to authorize their release if they are assassination records. I also reiterated that it is essential that the records of the Edwards Subcommittee (of the House Judiciary Committe) be located with respect to its hearings on the FBI's detruction of the Oswald note. Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
