Jeremy:I have spoken to Eileen and Doug about doing the Vietnam release the week of December15. Doug pointed out that he is on leave that week and the next week, although he said it didn't matter if he was around (he really would like to be around). We could do it the week before, the week of Monday, December 8, if we are ready. Eileen FedExed me documents for arrival today, so I'll have more of a chance to look at them.Have you looked at the Vietnam documents in any more detail? Any thoughts on what the "story" is in them? We know the May 1963 SecDef Conference document has not been released anywhere (at least not by the Johnson Library or the Kennedy Library).Secondly, Doug told me that he has some more Califano documents that now have RIFs on them. He was going to review the contents to see if there is anything new in there.Given the Pentagon reaction to the Cuba release, I wanted to advise you of the rough plans, just in case we need to do something differently the next time around.Tom
