Don't know how helpful this will be, but here goes:1) In the last year or two, the AZ legislature passed a "Hate-Crimes" bill; the lead sponsor was State Representative Robin Shaw. Her office number is 602/542-5408.2) There's a professor at ASU Law School, David Kader, who recently lectured to a Jewish community group on the subject of religious freedom. His office number is 602/965-6386.3) At various points over the years, the local chapter of the ACLU has gotten involved in religious freedom issues as they relate to the American Indian Church and native american religious practices generally. The current Director of the Phoenix chapter is Eleanor Eisenberg, who is out of town this week; I don't know what they've been doing lately on the subject, but their number is 602/650-1967.4) I called the Civil Rights Division (602/542-5263) of the AZ Attorney General's office, but they don't seem to do anything on this issue.5) There's an Arizona Indian Affairs Commission; I've left a message w/them inquiring as to whether they do anything on these issues.I'll forward more as I get it; let me know if this is not the kind of information you're seeking.
