Subject: Possible Opportunity to Teach Course on the JFK Assassination
Ron:As the ethics officer I wanted to consult with you on the following matter:I have raised with Jeremy a possible opportunity with which I have been presented to teach a 12 hour seminar on the JFK assassination at a small Massachusetts state college outside of Boston. The course, or seminar, would be for teachers who are seeking additional credits for a graduate degree or for increasing their salaries. The course would be taught on three or four Saturdays in the spring and the class would have approximately 10 students in it. The focus of the course would be looking at the assassination in the historical context of the Cold War.I am not sure what all of the relevant ethics considerations are, but here are what I believe are some points worth noting:The course would be about the assassination, not the Review Board.I would be teaching the course as a private individual, not as a representative of the Review Board.The time of the course (and course preparation) would be during non-Board working hours.My compensation would be approximately \$800 for the course.Please advise me if you need any additional information and what I need to do, if anything relative to this matter.
