Body: recstat:	Per your request, I kept an eye out for transcripts of MLK ELSUR during my perusal of Church Committee material this week. I did not come across any reference to Army ELSUR of MLK. Relative to FBI ELSUR of MLK, there were a couple items of possible interest: 1) in EBF 1125 there is a 4/18/68 memo from Brennan to Sullivan which lists wiretaps and microphone surveillance the Bureau put on MLK in the late '63 through '66 period. The list references locations and duration of various ELSUR; 2) EBF 1153 (an accordion-folder located in the back left of the bottom drawer of the two-drawer file cabinet near Margaret's desk) primarily consists of material relevant to ELSUR on MLK, including a copy of the FBI monograph "The Real Martin Luther King". This latter document has an entire section devoted to MLK's personal life in which extensive use is made of direct quotations from ELSUR of MLK. These are excerpts, though, not complete transcripts of any given ELSUR.I'm pretty certain that the last time I was here working on Church material I saw a long verbatim ELSUR transcript reflecting, I believe, a January 1964 stay at the Willard Hotel by MLK and associates. I can't be sure now where in the Church Committee material I saw it, however.For what it's worth. Record
