She confirmed Henry Person's information that the title of the incumbent would be the "district intelligence officer." He would run the "DIO," or District Intelligence Office. I called back and told her we had been informed that such DIO records would be part of RG 181, and I asked her whom in the Navy the Review Board should ask for such DIO records--ONI, NCIS, or some other part of the Navy such as OGC. She said she would do some checking and would try to have an answer for us on Wednesday. END
