The purpose of the meeting was to take stock of where the Criminal Division stands in completing its work under the JFK Act. We were shown the remaining records that the Criminal Division must process, which consist of materials from the Criminal Division's 129-11 file on the Kennedy assassination, materials from Roger Cubbage/Jeff Fogel (assigned by the Division to handle JFK assassination matters after the HSCA had completed its work in 1979), and materials referred to the Criminal Division by other agencies. The volume of these materials was approximately two to three boxes (very roughly between a 100 and 200 documents -- this does not include the separate materials recently identified by Review Board staff from the Division's organized crime files). We emphasized, as the first priority, the need to complete processing of materials from the 129-11 file and Warren Commission-related documents, and to respond to outstanding referrals, particularly from FBI and the Office of Information and Privacy. We said that we would like to have the Criminal Division complete all its obligations under the JFK Act by this Summer, and we agreed to meet again in May to review the status of the Criminal Division's work.
