Subject: FYI Only: "Eastland Committee"/Senate Internal Security Subcommittee investigation of FPCC
The Internal Security Subcommittee of the Senate Judiciary Committee, also known as the "Eastland Committee" held at least one Executive Session hearing on the FPCC, on 5/5/60, and questioned FPCC sponsors Robert Taber (former WCBS radio newswriter), Kenneth Tynan (British drama critic and contributor to The New Yorker) and Carleton Beals. This was within a month of the 4/6/60 full-page ad taken out by the FPCC in the NYTimes, announcing its existence and listing sponsors ranging from Simone de Beauvoir to Norman Mailer to Truman Capote to Taber and Tynan. This Executive Hearing/interrogation is referenced several times in the FBI NY Field Office file on the FPCC.
