He admitted up-front to losing the two FEDEX envelopes we had mailed to him earlier.I noted that the phone number he left for me in his voice mail message (972 743 6149) was different than his phone number at the time we mailed him the transcripts, implying that he had moved and had a different address. On May 28, both Cathy Rodriguez and I, following Jeremy Gunn's instructions to mail him two more FEDEX envelopes, attempted to call Mr. Groden at the following phone number, which he had left for us in his voice mail message: (972) 743-6149. The number was not a good oneall we got was a "not in service" recording. Therefore, we were unable to obtain his current address and unable to mail him the two FEDEX envelopes.I went the extra mile and called the information operator for area code 972, and ascertained that it was still in Texas, but she had no listing for the name Robert Groden, and said that 972 743 6149 was not a working number.End Result: because Robert Groden left us a non-working number, and did not leave us his new mailing address, we cannot send him 2 FEDEX envelopes.
