The Library stated that these recordings would be opened along with the next scheduled release of presidential recordings. Please inform us of the date(s) when these tapes will be released.Mildred Stegall Name FilesAs of yet, the name files identified by Review Board staff in March 1997 as being of potential interest have not been reviewed for assassination related material. Given the time constraints, we request that the LBJ Library make the folders available for a member of the Review Board staff to review on site to determine whether they contain assassination records. Once that determination has been made, the Review Board will request authorization from the FBI to release the files. The LBJ Library will then be responsible for transferring the records to the JFK Collection.I also wrote in a few other changes on the letter itself. The wording is probably a little rough, but I just wanted you to have the gist of what I want to say.
