I haven't tried to put in an 11 or 12, etc.Also, when I'm working in an issue and I go into a screen I've worked in previously and have saved and I want to edit that screen (let's say Notes, because I realize I missed putting in a piece of information) when I go into the Notes screen a second time, and hit "edit document" I loose the number of the issue at the top of the page. This is not a tragedy while I'm on the screen, but I often print out these screens to work on the hard copy and it is getting tricky to keep all the un-numbered pages separate. (This is not new, I've mentioned it before. The same lack of a number at the Issue position holds true for Call Reports, Notes, etc., etc. It would be great to have the issue number stay with the work.)Also, is there any way to assign a DATE FIELD on the view screen for the Notes screen. A date gets assigned for other tasks (outgoing correspondence, etc.) but the Notes come up with nothing.
