As you are aware, we were approached in New Orleans by a woman who attended the Board's June 28th public hearing and stated that her late mother, Barbara Reid, had been an investigator/researcher with Jim Garrison in the District Attorney's Office. The woman identified herself as Kelley Edmiston, 921 Chartres , #22, New Orleans, LA 70116. She gave a telephone number of (504) 523-4607. Edmiston was accompanied by her father, William. His telephone number is (504) 522-9212. Edmiston said that she had approximately six boxes of her mother's papers, accumulated while working in the District Attorney's Office. She thinks there are materials relevant to the Kennedy assassination investigation and expressed interest in giving us access to these records. I suggested she look at the materials more closely and told her that a representative from the Board would be in touch. I also gave her our address in case she wanted to follow-up with a letter, but to my knowledge she has not written to the Board.
