Assuming this Numbered Files document is not open at NARA II, should I presume that we want to run this by CIA simultaneously with the Immunized Executive Session testimony? There is some open Trafficante testimony (as I had remembered and referenced to you) in the Transcripts of Executive Sessions record series (different from the Immunized Executive Session testimony): 180-10110-10237 (Box 1). Having skimmed this quickly, it looks as if it is nothing more than Trafficante refusing to answer any questions on various constitutional grounds.
