I was responsible for 20 of the 23 HSCA documents (Joan handled the other 3) as well as the 4 documents characterized as "NARA". The four NARA documents, all from the Warren Commission era, represent the Board's clearing/processing of all the outstanding privacy-related redactions in Warren Commission-generated documents. That is to say, as of the Board's actions at this meeting, all Warren Commission era documents generated by the Commission itself (as opposed to third agency documents provided to the Commission) have been released in full to the public. For the HSCA records, the Board's actions at its 1/30-31 meeting represent an ongoing effort to clear HSCA privacy-related documents. This included more David Ferrie case documents, 4 HSCA collection documents concerning Robert Kennedy's murder and more VA-related medical records. Aside from Social Security Numbers, the Board is releasing all privacy-related material. The Board's HSCA agenda at this meeting also reflects a broadening of the Board's efforts to process HSCA-referred documents (third agency documents), a trend which will accelerate in months to come. Also, the Board voted on and opened -- for the first time -- documents from the HSCA Security Classified Files record series (2).In addition, referenced in the Federal Register notice for the meeting will be approximately 40 Dept. of State documents from the HSCA Security Classified Files record series which the DOS has reviewed and cleared for release at the Board's request (thus there was no vote on them at the meeting). The same is true of three Dept. of Defense files from the same record series. Hope this helps... let me know if you have any questions.
