Accordingly, please add the following items to your research agenda, and coordinate with each other as to who is trying to get what:FBI appropriations testimony for fiscal year 1965: as quoted in secondary sources, Hoover states that the FBI is using "every means at its disposal" to fight Soviet bloc intelligence. This particular statement would be very helpful, and does not appear in the appropriations testimony from other years that we have collected (which is also very helpful on several other points).The text of, and legislative history (reports, hearings) for, the Foreign Missions Act and amendments, with an eye toward statements that the Soviets and other Communist countries use their diplomatic establishments and personnel for intelligence purposes, and that accordingly the FBI devotes resources to "covering" such establishments and personnel.The text of, and legislative history (reports, hearings) for, the Right to Financial Privacy Act and amendments, with an eye toward statements that the FBI obtains bank records (optimally, of foreign establishments) in aid of its conterintelligence function.
