I've done some checking on this before, as part of the Dallas project. I have a couple documents and some RIFs in a folder, if you'd like to see them. There's no Purdy to Blakey communication, re: Dean, that I was able to find. The HSCA did interview him, more than once, though Purdy's name is not on the OCRs/transcripts (he was talked to as late as March of '79). Dean was very bitter about his treatment by the HSCA (and the Warren Commission, too, for that matter). There was, of course, a polygraph examination in '64, which Dean asked for. He came up with a list of questions he wanted to have asked of him. Copies of these are in the collection, but the actual polygraph results themselves are not. Dean was told that he failed the polygraph, but I don't believe he ever saw the results, per se. The HSCA contacted the Dallas PD to see if they could get ahold of the polygraph test/results, but were told that they weren't around and would have been "routinely" destroyed within a couple years of the test. Dave M. was able to determine that Patrick Dean is deceased, but he does have heirs. As of late '77, Dean claimed to have records, or at least copies of records: "assignments," "reports," his "interview with Ruby." I presume, but don't know for certain, that these are all in DPD files and thus already in the collection. One artifact Dean had which clearly isn't in the collection: Jack Ruby's signed copy of the Warren Commission Report. Dean visited Ruby in prison -- at Ruby's request -- and subsequently got a pair of glasses fixed for him. In return, or for other reasons, Ruby gave his copy of the report to Dean.
