Is there any reason why, on the bottom of p.1 and top of p.2 of the opening boilerplate, we state that "for each document, the number of releases of previously redacted information immediately follows the record identification number, followed in turn by...the status of the document," when in fact the status of the document does not appear in that location at all but at the top of each column--as in "Open in Full," etc. As of now, we list the document number, followed by the number of releases and number of postponements and, where appropriate, date of release or re-review, but not the document status.
