I called Stephanie Fawcett--since I hadn't been able to talk with you and therefore hadn't been able to return Will's call--and told her that it looked like State is on board, although funding not yet authorized. I asked when she thought the State team should arrive, and she suggested Monday, so she and they could talk before the reviewing began. When I asked whether she thought two State reviewers would be enough (CIA is bringing 6), she said that she wasn't sure, but that State would have a simpler job than CIA, given the way DOS has been proceeding with these records (mostly release). I suggested that she and Peggy Grafeld might want to talk, and Stephanie thought that was a good idea. I then left a message on Peggy's voice mail (the only way to communicate with her), giving her Stephanie's phone number and suggesting that she might want to discuss manpower and arrival time with her--unless she wanted me to handle it, which of course I'd be happy to do.
