DocumentsMorley's requests, as you'll probably recall, were rolled into a batch of Garrison-era "referred to  
CIA" HSCA documents which we forwarded to Barry Harrelson with a cover letter dated 5/16/86 (Barry didn't  
actually receive the documents until 5/20 or 5/21). Our letter indicated that our Board would be reveiwing  
these 45 documents (I think there were 6 DRE-related documents which Morley wanted) at its meeting of  
June 25-26, and we requested any evidence of postponements by June 18th. Of course, what we expect  
would happen is that Barry will get back to us in advance of the meeting date and simply indicate that we can  
clear them as consent releases.I have not yet heard back from Barry on the status of the 45 documents, or  
whether he expects to meet the meeting deadline of the 25th-26th. I wouldn't normally prick him with a  
reminder call until next week sometime, but I could do it sooner if that would be helpful to you in your  
dealings with Morley.FYI, I'll also put a copy of our 5/16 letter in your box.
