ReturnReceipt: This morning I talked on the phone to Mr. Charles Holmes, who is the individual who has the original of the Andrews Air Force Base log book in his possession. (He read from it as we were talking.) He is happy to send the book to us for inclusion in the JFK collection. He is sending it to the Pentagon office (Jessica Spencer) that we've previously been working with on Air Force documents. She will call us to pick it up as soon as she gets it. Mr. Holmes told me he was assigned to the Special Air Mission Wing at Andrews starting in 1968, and retrieved the log from the trash in 1973 when they were moving into a new headquarters building and were cleaning out a lot of old files. He doesn't know who originally wrote it, but said he would ask some of the other "old timers" there to see if anyone knows anything about it. BOTTOM LINE: We should have the original book this week, and I will do what I can to followup to see what else we can find out about its provenance, etc. I also promised Mr. Holmes that NARA would send him some kind of acknowledgement letter and clean photocopies of the log for his personal files. I'll work that out with Steve Tilley.
