Subject: Unredacted boxes HSCA/CIA Segregated Collection ("Staffer Notes") You'll recall that the HSCA portion of the CIA Segregated Collection (the so-called "Staffer Notes") was reviewed by CIA after passage of the JFK Act, returned unRIFed to NARA, who in turn RIFed it and sent it out to the public collection at NARA II, where it resides today. The public collection of this record series contains originals in any instance where CIA took no redactions, and copies where CIA took redactions. The unredacted versions of records which are redacted at NARA II reside in 23 boxes at NARA I (this is not a full duplicate set for the whole record series -- records opened in full by CIA exist only at NARA II). At my request, Kris Wilhelm has chatted with Diane Dimkoff about transferring the 23 boxes to our SCIF, where I think they would prove useful. Diane has no problem with it, and we should be able to implement the transfer some time in the next two weeks.
